TITLE: Non-Resident/Non-US Citizen Students

The Brattleboro Union High School District #6 Board of Directors recognizes the educational and cultural benefits which accrue from hosting students from outside the United States. However, we need to balance these benefits against potential stresses to our limited resources. Therefore, the acceptance and placement of such students in the District is at the discretion of the District's administrators, who shall use the following guidelines:

- 1. A student participating in an exchange program sanctioned by the District shall follow the protocols of the particular program while a guest of the District and community.
- 2. A student who is a guest of a resident of the District may apply to attend Brattleboro Union High School. A student wishing to receive credit shall pay the customary tuition charges. For a student not wishing to receive credit, tuition charges will be waived. In either case, such a student will be allowed to attend Brattleboro Union High School only as space is available.
- 3. A student who is part of a formal program (i.e., AFS), but who is not associated with a program sanctioned by the District, will be accepted and placed in accord with the guidelines in category 2, above.

The District Board may be petitioned for exceptions to this policy, the Board's decision in such cases shall be final and unappealable.
