

TITLE: Parental Notification

CODE: LBP-9

The BUHS District #6 Board of Directors recognizes and appreciates the importance of notifying parents as soon as possible when their child is involved as a suspect (as determined by the administration), victim or accused party in a serious disciplinary matter that could result in, at a minimum, a suspension from school. In an effort to balance this notification with the administration's need to act in a timely fashion concerning school discipline, it is the policy of the board that administrators make every effort to notify parents within one school day when their child is involved as a suspect, victim or accused, unless law enforcement official specifically request a postponement of the notification. The board also recognizes that during an investigation this parental notification could be delayed for a variety of reasons, but once the administrative investigation has concluded, parents should be notified within the next 24-hour period.
